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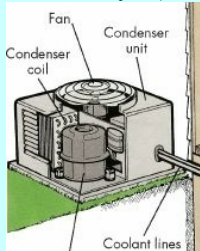


Our Mission

HEATING OIL CONTRACTS AND YOU

We're just getting to the end of another chaotic year in the heating business, caused by unrelenting price volatility and unprecedented temperature swings. ***Would you believe Easter was colder than Christmas this year?*** We wanted to share some information about the fixed price contracts we offer.

Like any contract, both sides have to fulfill their ends of the bargain. We promise to provide the fuel to keep you warm. You promise to pay an agreed upon price.

CT law requires that we secure 75% of our oil purchases to ensure the oil is there when you need it. Because of this, we are not really able to take advantage

of any price movement, because we already own the majority of product for the year.

We've been buying next year's oil since January. Our contracts for next year will arrive in July, and we will be offering a new choice next year, called a "cap" or "ceiling". This provides downside protection if the market should drop unusually low during the winter (like this past year). However, this type of downside protection carries a premium price, as we have to purchase options in order to capitalize on a falling market. Look for the additional choice on our pricing programs this summer.

COLDER THAN LAST YEAR?

Despite the unusual warmth we saw during November and December, this winter was actually colder than last winter! Due to the brutally cold February and colder than normal March and April, the 2006-2007 heating season was statistically colder (as measured by degree days) than last year. What this means to our customers is that many households will wind up using more heating oil than projected, which could result in an end of year balance. We will send out statements in June to notify all customers where their balance stands.



CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS



We sent all of our customers a letter this winter offering to drop off Carbon Monoxide Detectors at the time of your annual tune-up, and we were amazed at the response! We are delighted to be able to contribute to a sense of security in your home, and

will continue to offer this product moving forward. If you don't want to wait until it is time for your annual tune-up, stop by our office and pick up a CO detector today! They are simple to install, plug in to a standard A/C outlet, and have a battery backup in case of a power outage.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF CONNECTICUT TAX LAWS

Purchase an *Energy Star* rated Boiler, Hot Water Heater or Furnace prior to June 30th, 2007 and take advantage of a sales tax holiday.

Labor and other parts, pipes and fittings are still taxable.
